Director of Orchestra Position Description at West Senior High School

Specific Duties

Teaching and Performance

- Rehearse and conduct the curricular orchestras: Concert Orchestra, Symphony Orchestra and Philharmonic Orchestra at West High School; 6th, 7th and 8th grade orchestras plus string ensemble at West Middle School
- Full Orchestra with rehearsals with limited school day rehearsals and Monday evening rehearsals (October – June)
- Collaboratively organize and rehearse the musical orchestra
- Organize, teach, and continue to foster the solo & ensemble and chamber music program
- Organize, teach and program concerts scheduled throughout the year
- Participate in MSBOA Concert Festivals, MSBOA Solo & Ensemble with encouragement to participate in MASTA/ASTA activities

Administrative

- Director of Orchestras at West Senior High and West Middle School
- Work collaboratively with TCAPS District Music Program staff
- Coordination with WSH music colleagues and district wide orchestra directors, development of schedules, curriculum, budget, handbooks, communications, programs, etc.
- Provide supervision, record keeping, and arrange for the maintenance of an extensive inventory of string instrument and uniform inventory. Maintain an orchestral music library.
- Work collaboratively with district wide music boosters organization as well as area parents with the WSH orchestra program.
- Demonstrate and maintain "total school and community" awareness in dealing with students, parents, administration, teaching staff, and community members.

Desired musical skills

- Versatile musician with varied musical interests
- Experienced concert conductor of advanced literature with advanced rehearsal skills including full orchestra repertoire
- Strong orchestral pedagogical skills
- Evidence of a strong applied background and advanced instrumental study
